Nézőpont Intézet Foundation calls for scholarship applications in the following theme:

Governmental Stability in Central Europe – Trends, Opportunities, Challenges

The scope of the research program is the development of a complex report on the governmental stability of 12 Central European countries. Current proposal invites Central European researchers to take part in creating the report with their oral and written analyses. The program aims to examine different factors of governmental stability with special focus on the following ones:

- public opinion on government
- unity within the government
- cooperation of coalition parties
- government opposition relation
- constitutional framework
- media image of the government
